POWER is seeking a Clinical Director who reports to the Chief Operating Officer (COO). The Clinical Director has overall responsibility for the implementation, delivery, and coordination of POWER's programs and services, and the supervision of five Program Managers.

The Clinical Director provides clinical supervision using evidence based practices and is responsible for programs being fully utilized and operating at capacity. The Clinical Director ensures quality service delivery by developing and leading staff, articulating and reinforcing expectations; holding Managers accountable for compliance with external and internal standards, regulations, policies, and procedures; and developing and implementing the agency's annual training plan. The Clinical Director is responsible for implementing POWER's new Electronic Medical Record (EMR) system and ensuring medical records are accurate, complete, and in compliance with licensing regulations and legal and ethical standards.

The Clinical Director works closely with the COO to integrate substance use and mental health treatment and identify gaps in services.

Qualifications include: A Master's Degree in Social Work, Counseling or related field, and a minimum of five (5) years of clinical experience in a drug and alcohol or mental health setting, three (3) of which have been in a clinical supervision and/or management capacity. LCSW or LPC is required.
