POWER's mission is to help women reclaim their lives from addiction and related emotional health issues and improve the well-being of future generations.



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

Welcome to POWER Restore

Located in the East End Behavioral Health Hospital, POWER Restore is a 21-bed program offering two integrated levels of care to help you transition seamlessly from managing withdrawal symptoms to beginning your recovery journey.



Typically 3-5 days detox from active use. Clients receive physician services and 24-hour nursing. Medication to manage symptoms is readily available.



Typically 14-28 days to focus on building a foundation for your recovery. Treatment includes individual and group therapy focused on trauma-informed care and gender-specific issues.

When you come to POWER Restore, you will have your own bedroom with private bath. You will also be given a handbook that contains helpful information about what to expect during your stay. You will work with a team of doctors, nurses, therapists, and recovery support staff to address the needs that matter most to you.

POWER Restore is part of a range of women-focused addiction treatment and support services offered by POWER. You will be able to easily move through different levels of care as your recovery progresses.

POWER Restore Services

POWER Restore is the first treatment program in Pennsylvania to offer integrated withdrawal management and rehab in an all-woman environment.

Continuum of Care

In addition to **detox and rehab**, POWER offers:

- Screening, assessment, and referral to treatment when you call the POWER Line
- Residential treatment at POWER House
- Outpatient therapy, including intensive outpatient programming (IOP) at POWER New Day
- Recovery support services, including mentoring, through the POWER Connection program
